GETTING TO VALENCIA

FLYING INTERNATIONAL

Your most convenient option is Valencia Airport, which is a well serviced international airport.

Alternatively, you could land in Madrid or Barcelona, and then travel to Valencia by train or car.

FROM MADRID

Madrid is very well connected with Valencia with a high-speed train (AVE). The trip takes only 1h30 and runs every hour or so and tickets range from EUR 25 to Eur 75. Tickets can be purchased on Renfe's website: https://www.renfe.com/es/en

Should you fancy a road trip, Valencia is also well connected by highway from all the main cities in Spain. A trip from Madrid would approximately take you 3h30.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION IN VALENCIA

Taxis are safe and reliable and can be booked directly with the municipal services on this number +34-963-70-33-33

Uber is not in operations in the region, however, we recommend you use Cabify when booking cabs over an App. It is very reliable and more economic than taking Taxis off the streets. You can also schedule a trip in advance (for example, when returning back to the airport, or when using the service late at night, as the number of drivers can be low during the darkest hours and wait times might increase unless pre-ordered).
